

## Welcome Bob Renner

Mr. Renner was born in Valley Forge, PA on February 21<sup>st</sup>, 1955. He attended High School at Central Bucks West and lived in Chalfont, PA with his parents and 5 other siblings until he joined the Marine Corps on May 19<sup>th</sup>, 1972. Bob had a very distinguished career in the Marine Corps having served in many leadership and administration positions before his retirement on Jun 30<sup>th</sup>, 1992. Upon his retirement, Mr. Renner went to work for a brief period from July 1992 until March 1993 as the Office Manager for a Law Firm in Washington, DC until he was hired as the Administrative Officer for the Separation and Retirement Branch, Headquarters Marine Corps, Personnel Management Division, Manpower Department. He served in that capacity until February 1997 when he was hired as the Supervisor for the

Publishing Management Section, Publishing & Logistics Management Branch, Administration and Resource Management Division. In February of 2001 he was promoted to the position as the Head of the Printing and Publishing Management Section until June 2004 when the Section was merged and he became the Assistant Section Head of the Publishing and Logistics Management Section until his retirement on August 31<sup>st</sup> 2013. Mr. Renner currently resides in Woodbridge, VA.

In his Legion Career, Mr. Renner has been a member of The American Legion in the Department of Virginia for thirty two years; and has served three terms as Commander of Post 130 in Falls Church.
