Arkansas Boys State is an immersive leadership and leadership experience designed for high school juniors.

During their week at Arkansas Boys State, students — referred to as delegates — are assigned a political party, city, and county. Throughout the week, delegates build and operate a mock government from the ground up, as if it were real:

- solve municipal challenges
- engage constituents

April and May — Set your students up for success.
