Here is what you need to know:

Registration is \$250 per delegate. This great value covers delegate materials and mementos, housing and meals at UCA, and operating costs associated with hosting a premier leadership program.

We are actively contacting schools and guiding them through registration. If you work alongside local school districts to nominate and fund students' attendance, please reach out to the school to begin conversations about Arkansas Boys State 2025.

- High schools should nominate their best and brightest male students who are currently juniors: mature leaders in the classroom, on the field, and throughout the community who are ready to shape the future of our state. Schools are welcome to nominate as many eligible students for whom funding can be secured.
- The deadline for schools to nominate students and for those students to complete registration is April 4, and schools must be the ones to nominate students for attendance.
