The American Legion Arkansas Boys State Commission invites your school to register students for the 83rd session of our life-changing leadership and civic engagement experience, which is **at the University of Central Arkansas (UCA) in Conway, Arkansas, from May 25–30, 2025.**

Who should I send to Arkansas Boys State?

High schools should nominate their best and brightest male students who are currently juniors: mature leaders in the classroom, on the field, and throughout the community who are ready to shape the future of our state. You are welcome to nominate as many eligible students for whom you can secure funding.

There is no limit on how many students your school can send; however, a good place to start is 10% of your male junior class. We ask that you send as many eligible students as best represent your school and for whom you can secure funding.

How much does Arkansas Boys State cost?

Registration is \$250 per student. This great value covers student materials and mementos, housing and meals at UCA, and operating costs associated with hosting a premier leadership program. More on payment and financial support is available at **arboysstate.org/registration**.

How do I register my students?

To begin registration, visit **arboysstate.org/registration**. First, you will select students for attendance. Then, those students will receive an email from us prompting them to complete registration, and you will receive an email with next steps. The registration deadline is April 4.
